4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Inhalation: Move to fresh air in case of accidental inhalation of vapours or decomposition

5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Inhalation: Inhalation of vapors from uncured sealant may cause respiratory tract irritation. When heated to

temperatures exceeding 300° F (150° C) in the presence of air, silicones may form formaldehyde vapors. Formaldehyde is a potential cancer hazard and a known skin and respiratory sensitizer. Vapors irritate the eyes, nose and throat. Safe handling conditions may be maintained by keeping formaldehyde vapor concentrations below the OSHA permissible

limit.

Skin contact: Prolonged or repeated contact with uncured sealant may cause skin irritation. May cause

allergic skin reaction.

Eye contact: Vapors may irritate eyes. Contact with eyes will cause irritation.

Ingestion: Not expected under normal conditions of use. May be harmful if swallowed.
